第一部分 听力

Text 1

第一节

A

【语篇导读】本文是一篇应用文,介绍了去以色列港市埃拉特旅游的相关事宜。

21. A 【解析】推理判断题。根据第二段中 Eilat is blessed weather-wise — rain is rare, sunshine is near constant and it is seldom windy. 可知,埃拉特雨水很少,阳光充足也很少起风,这样的天气很适合旅游,故选 A。

22. C 【解析】细节理解题。根据第三段中 Dive companies like Aqua Sport will bring first-time divers out for an introductory session in the company of an instructor. 可知,那里的潜水公司会为初学潜水的人提供有指导员陪同的介绍性训练环节,也就是说让初学者也能体验潜水,故选 C。

23. A 【解析】细节理解题。根据最后一段中 Walking for a number of hours through a narrow valley and climbing a mountain for a 360-degree view of your surroundings 可知,只有 A 项沿着埃拉特徒步旅行符合题意。

B

【语篇导读】本文是记叙文。叙述了一个名字叫 Kayley 的小女孩目睹了邻居家被大火烧毁,然后用自己的行动为邻居筹款的故事。通过此文,我们看到了孩子金子般的心。

24. C 【解析】细节理解题。根据第一段中 ... who raised funds to help by opening a lemonade stand. 可知,这个女孩开了一个柠檬汽水摊位来筹钱帮助他们,故选 C。

25. C 【解析】推理判断题。根据第二段中 People even drove over from far away after hearing about how devoted Kayley was. 可知,人们纷纷开车从大老远过来支持她是因为听到了她这么用心做这件事,也就是 Kayley 关爱他人的举动触动了他们。故选 C。

26. A 【解析】细节理解题。根据最后一段中 But the fire hydrant (消防栓) across from the house failed and caused a 15-minute delay in getting water on the fire. 可知,房子对面的消防栓坏了,因此耽误了 15 分钟的给水灭火,A 项中的 broke down 对应关键句中的 failed,故选 A。

27. D 【解析】标题归纳题。通读文章可知,一场无情的大火毁灭了 Kayley 邻居的家园,可是她却及时用自己的方式关爱他们,D 项作为标题最恰当。

C

【语篇导读】本文是新闻报道。上海是中国第一个

强制垃圾分类的城市,如今垃圾分类已经是全国家喻户晓的话题之一。然而还是有很多人对于如何进行垃圾分类很是困惑,为此政府加大了宣传力度,也有些人开始制作出帮助垃圾分类的 APP 供市民方便使用。

28. D 【解析】细节理解题。结合第二段第一句,他们可以将语音和图片识别技术应用于 APP 和其他智能手机服务,以引导上海居民进行垃圾分类, D 项谈到一些 APP 可能用来帮助实施这项计划,符合题意,故选 D。
29. B 【解析】推理判断题。由第三段可知,为了使这一过程顺利进行并提高公众的认识,上海政府开展了一项以海报和电视节目为特色的介绍垃圾分类方法的宣传活动。由此可知,运用媒体介绍垃圾分类技巧是为了更容易实施这项计划,故选 B。
30. D 【解析】细节理解题。根据最后一段中 Actually, Liu Yiyi added, as Chinese become accustomed to the rules, people will use the apps less often. 可知,随着人们熟悉了这些规则,他们今后会更少使用这些 APP。故选 D。
31. C 【解析】主旨大意题。根据第一段导语内容可知本文讲述了程序人员如何设计程序来帮助实施垃圾分类计划的,故选 C。

D

【语篇导读】本文是一篇议论文。用可再生能源发电可以大大节约成本和开支,这也是可持续发展的必经之路,更是未来的一种趋势。

32. D 【解析】细节理解题。根据第二段中 Within the next year, electricity produced by wind will be consistently cheaper than electricity by any fossil-fuel source, the report forecasts. 可知,风能发的电比化石燃料发的电要更便宜, D 项符合题意。
33. B 【解析】词义猜测题。根据上文可知,化石燃料的使用打乱了气候模式,这样就加快了全球向可再生能源改变的一个步伐,此处 boost 表示“加速,促进”,与 B 项 advance 一致。
34. D 【解析】推理判断题。通读第四段可知,作者采用的是给出数据进行对比的方式来说明自己的观点。故选 D。
35. A 【解析】推理判断题。最后一段第一句指出,可再生能源使用的成本会在未来继续下降,紧接着提出了风能和太阳能光伏项目将低于最便宜的化石燃料的使用,由此可知,在未来,可再生能源会成为一种更大的趋势, A 项符合题意。

41. B 【解析】苏珊一直喜欢做衣服,十几岁就设计出各种各样的(various)款式。
42. A 【解析】然而在中途她的梦想受阻,让她的时尚梦很难继续走下去, further 表示进一步朝前走,符合题意。
43. B 【解析】在慈善会工作之前,做了服务员的工作,也做了厨师的工作,表示做某项服务类工作可以用动词 serve。
44. B 【解析】政府削减支出就意味着不再做很多慈善,那样作者做慈善的日子减少(reduce)了。
45. C 【解析】那时候就想正好可以抓住机会(chance)学一些自己喜欢做的事情。
46. A 【解析】结合上一题,学一些自己喜欢做的事情, catch one's fancy 意为“中某人的意”,符合题意。
47. B 【解析】她很有时尚方面的天赋,但是不得不放弃工作去追梦,结合下文 quit her job 可知是放弃工作, give up 意为“放弃”。
48. C 【解析】要放弃工作,当然是很艰难的决定, tough 意为“艰难的”。
49. A 【解析】尽管如此,自己又不想放弃时尚设计这一块, design 意为“设计”,符合题意。
50. D 【解析】内心斗争多年,在 61 岁的时候,她放弃工作去追梦, follow 意为“追随”,符合题意。
51. A 【解析】她说自己很喜欢那些诸如弄被子,蜡染法还有图案设计这些与时尚设计有关的技术。 technique 意为“技巧,技术”。
52. B 【解析】在这个方面,她觉得自己如鱼得水,从来没有那么开心过,用否定词加上比较级表示最高级,故选 never。
53. D 【解析】根据上文提到了大学可知,此处指她下定决心要去读一个和时尚设计有关的学位。 be determined to do 符合题意。
54. A 【解析】那里的老师们对她的设计印象深刻。 be impressed with 意为“对……印象深刻”。
55. B 【解析】此处指被选去参加毕业时尚周的展览对她来说更是锦上添花。 pick 意为“挑选”。
56. D 【解析】她自己说这对她来说是一次非常好的(amazing)经历,她在享受着每一分钟。
57. A 【解析】这让她知道自己接下来要做什么,那就是在时尚圈工作。 fashion circle 意为“时尚圈”。
58. B 【解析】很多在她这个年纪的人都会觉得继续自

己的梦想几乎不可能。continue 意为“继续”。

59. D 【解析】千里之行始于足下,此处用 journey 指旅行,也暗指人生之旅。

60. A 【解析】用你得到的做你能够做的,不要让年龄成了你的障碍(barrier)。
