24. B **【解析】**细节理解题。根据第二段末句可知,勒·柯布西耶建筑师后期的作品都充满了人性和温暖。故选 B。

25. C **【解析】**推理判断题。根据第三段内容可知,作者在这次游览中从勒·柯布西耶以及同行的人们那里学会了不抱怨、学会了如何与他人相处以及如何互相扶持等。由此推断作者说到妻子是想表明他内心发生的转变。

26. C **【解析】**推理判断题。根据最后一段中 particularly significant 和 I am just getting started 可知作者持积极态度。故选 C。

27. D **【解析】**主旨大意题。文章主要介绍了作者在一次旅游中受到建筑师 Le Corbusier 的故事以及同行人们的影响,意识到无论多大年龄人们都可以改变自己、重塑自我。故选 D。

【语篇导读】本文是一篇说明文。Cobb 因为研究点受到极端气候的影响,珊瑚大量死亡,而开始关注气候变化,她从自身做起,减少飞行从而降低碳排放。

34. D **【解析】**推理判断题。文章介绍了蜜蜂用塑料废片筑巢的现象,由此推断这是一篇科普性文章,应该出现在杂志中。故选 D。

35. C **【解析】**细节理解题。根据第二段和末段内容可知,研究人员认为蜜蜂利用塑料筑巢为了生存而发展了适应环境的新特点。
