第一部分 听力

Text 1

第一节

A

【语篇导读】本文是应用文。文章介绍了美国加州的四个不同的自行车旅游的目的地以及相关的旅游事项,包括游客年龄层次,旅游团体的人数,交通方式及时间费用等信息。

21. B 【解析】推理判断题。根据第二个旅行介绍可知,它的地点在 Los Gatos;再根据该部分中的 Our saving: \$103 From US \$2,477 可知,游客应付 $2477 - 103 = 2374$ 美元。

22. C 【解析】细节理解题。根据 Sonoma & Napa Valley Bike Tour 部分中的 ... and 4 other destinations ... 可知,它提供总共五个旅游目的地。

23. D 【解析】细节理解题。根据 Death Valley Bike Tour 部分的介绍可知,除了 Las Vegas 以外,它还有 7 other destinations(七个其他的目的地)。因此是这四个中最多的。

B

【语篇导读】本文是记叙文。文章通过 Green 的案例,展示了智能手表在疾病预警方面的作用。

24. B 【解析】细节理解题。根据第二段可知,Green 工作之余休息时,爬了一座小山就觉得上气不接下气,这对于经常锻炼,身体体型非常好的他来说是不正常的。故选 B。

25. C 【解析】细节理解题。根据第三段可知,Green 一直以为是工作压力,他的医生也以为是焦虑造成的,根本没有想到是血栓;第五段的第二句明确说明,CT 扫描的结果显示,他的左肺又形成了血栓。故选 C。

26. A 【解析】细节理解题。这次的问题是一开始他自己觉得有问题;然后再看智能手表,发现有警告;咨询医生,医生初步判断由于焦虑导致的;后来医生根据智能手表的数据前后对比,决定使用 CT 扫描,才确认问题严重,马上送往急救室。故选 A。

27. D 【解析】主旨大意题。本文通过 Green 自己锻炼后身体出现的健康问题被自己佩戴的智能手表检测

出来,从而帮助自己得到及时的治疗。因此,文章主旨是叙述智能手表在生活中可以帮助挽救性命。故 D 项为最佳标题。

C

【语篇导读】本文是议论文。不同地方温度和气候不一样,常常会有一些地方春天来得很早,也有一些地方来得比较晚,这一现象究竟是好是坏呢?

28. A 【解析】细节理解题。根据第一段 Depending on where you live ... 以及第二段中对地域差异性的说明可知,人们感觉到不同的春天到来的时间的原因在于地域的差异性,故选 A。
29. D 【解析】推理判断题。根据第三段 These are models scientists have developed to predict the start of spring based on ... 可知,这些地图反映出不同的地方有不同的春天到来的时间,有些地方早来,有些地方晚到,故 D 项符合题意。
30. B 【解析】推理判断题。根据最后两段可知,作者一方面肯定了春天来得早会带来好处,另一方面也指出春天来得太早会打乱了生态平衡,因此作者对此的态度是客观的,故选 B。
31. B 【解析】主旨大意题。通读全文可知,本文主要是围绕春季到来的不同时间而展开讨论的,故选 B 项。

D

【语篇导读】本文是说明文。根据《国家地理》杂志周四的一篇报道称,科学家们在激光探测与测量的帮助下,在危地马拉发现了一处巨大的玛雅“城市”遗迹。文章介绍了被发现的玛雅古城的一些情况。

32. A 【解析】推理判断题。根据第二段内容尤其是最后两句可知,本段主要介绍激光探测这项技术的作用。因为这项技术近年来有许多显著的发现,包括吴哥窟、柬埔寨和伯利兹城的主要发现。因此,文章主要是通过举例来强调其重要性的。
33. B 【解析】词义猜测题。根据本段意思可知,隐藏在玛雅保护区的茂密丛林里,由 PACUNAM 基金会和研究人员从空中搜集的图像显示有超过 6 万多座房屋、宫殿和其他人造设施,甚至还有“高架公路”。这些让专家们重新思考玛雅帝国的规模和复杂性。因此,Those 此处是指保护区内的人造设施。
34. D 【解析】推理判断题。根据文章内容和倒数第二段可知,通过这些古人建造的遗址得知,他们有非常丰富的文化基础,但新的研究显示,这个社会的规模程度远远超出了专家们的想象。因此,综合可形容玛雅帝国为浩瀚巨大的和先进的。
35. C 【解析】推理判断题。根据文章最后一段可知,国家地理探险家埃斯特拉达·贝利是该项目的联合

负责人,他说:“我们从不知道的城市群都在调查数据中出现,还有两万多平方公里需要探索,将有数百个我们不知道的城市在那里”。因此,他们接下来会继续探索未知的城市。

45. C 【解析】工人们放下一根绳子,共同努力把狗拉(pull)上来到安全的地方。
46. A 【解析】这里是指那些发现(found)并救上那条狗的钻塔里的工作人员们。
47. B 【解析】他们救上那条狗后很快就给它取了个名字(name)。根据后面的 The name 可知。
48. C 【解析】这个名字 Boonrod 在泰语中类似(similar)于“幸存者”之意。
49. D 【解析】Vitisak Payalaw 是救援那条狗的工作人员(workers)中的一位。
50. B 【解析】Vitisak Payalaw 一直在他的脸谱网上提供(providing)关于 Boonrod 的更新信息。
